This survey was given by phone – no mail or e-mail deliveries

FWD asked each active participant seven (7) questions that would offer suggestions on how to improve, do things differently and what impact it made on their lives.

The average participant has been involved over two years and most of them heard about FWD by word of mouth.

The website is underutilized by current participants.

The most popular events for the participants were: Detroit River Boat, Bowling, Concert in the Park, Gull Meadows, and the Gala.

The recommendations for improvement were to provide a sharing together event where the participants can just talk to each other and really get to know each other better.

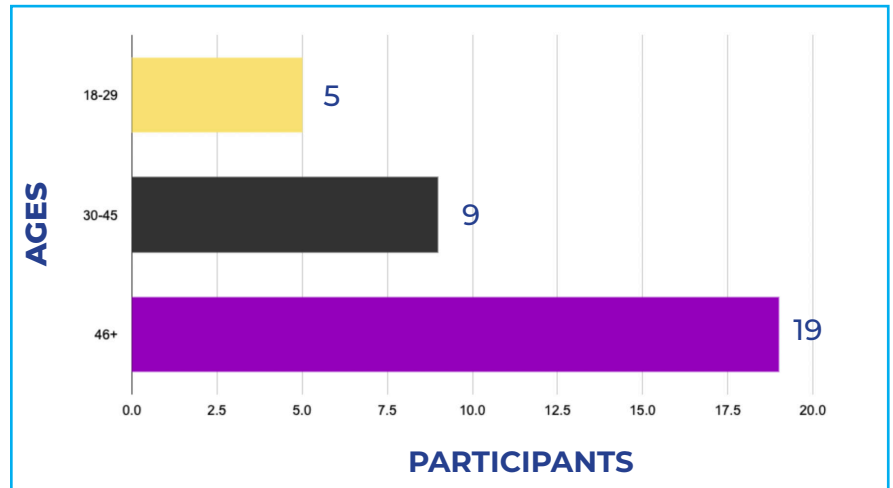
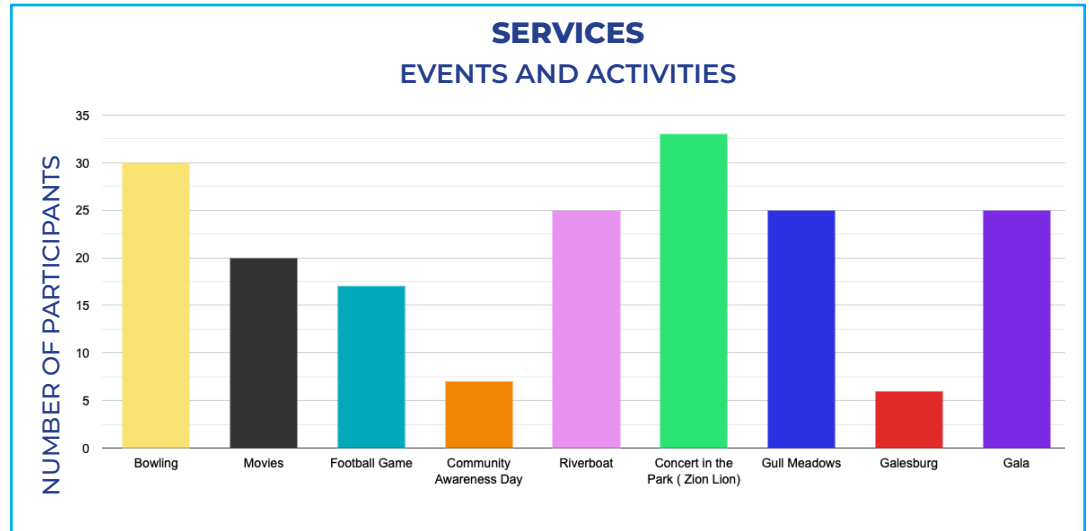
